Job Description and Responsibilities

The Early Childhood Classroom Assistant assists the lead teacher with a range of daily tasks to support students and the program. These may include:

- Assisting the lead teacher in planning and teaching the curriculum
- Assisting in classroom management
- Supervising the students in the classroom and throughout the school
- Preparing and restoring classroom materials and supplies
- Working with students as a class, small group, and individually
- Assisting with coordination, facilitation, and monitoring of teaching activities, including field trips and on-site experiences
